Note on Closure of All India Trade Test (AITT), 2020

This is further to the Note on AITT, 2020 published on 28th December, 2020, wherein, the plan of conducting AITT, 2020 vide CBT in phase wise manner was released by DGT, MSDE.

- 2. In view of the plan as above, the examination (both CBT and Practical/Engineering Drawing) are being conducted both for the outgoing trainees (i.e 2nd year of 2018-2020 batch and final exams for 2019-2020 batch and also for 1st year trainees of 2019-2021 batch).
- 3. All attempts were made to give chances to the trainees who could not appear in the examination in subsequent phases. However, DGT, MSDE needs to draw a timeline for closure of the examination process to enable timely declaration of results to enable issuance of the e- National Trade Certificate (e-NTC) to the passed out trainees. These NTC holders will be able to enter job market adding value to the Nation. In this regard, it is accordingly required that all the remaining trainees desirous of taking up the examination may complete the process of fee payment by 28th March, 2021 to enable themselves being mapped by the State/UTs authorities for appearing in the final phase of CBT planned to be held during first/second week of April, 2021. It is also being informed that after this concluding phase the AITT, 2020 examinations would be deemed to be concluded and the process of result declaration shall be indicated.
- 4. For the trainees who even after this phase are unable to take part in these examinations will have to take their attempt in the supplementary examinations which shall be held within 60 days of declaration of final results.
- 5. This issues with approval of the Competent authority.
