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**Final Recommendation Report of the Sub-committee formed to Study and Recommend on Feasibility of 4 trade criterion**

2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the sub-committee to Study and Recommend Feasibility of 4 trade criterion was held on 24.06.2021 to discuss and deliberate on:

1. Examining the minimum 4 trade criterion for the existing ITIs
2. Recommendations on Implementation of Minimum 4 trade criterion for existing ITIs
3. To suggest changes in the norms for Infrastructure for maintaining minimum 4 trades
4. Time Frame within which the existing ITIs should comply and adopt the Norms

1<sup>st</sup> Meeting of this Sub-committee was held on March 3, 2021. As discussed in the meeting, a questionnaire was shared with ITIs for their expansion and capacity building options for Implementation of 4 Trade Criteria. The Google form for the same was shared with all the ITIs and 3,338 responses for the Questionnaire were received, out of which 2309 ITIs have less than 4 trades. The committee studied the responses. The details of the response are:

The committee reviewed the responses.

On the need of Minimum 4 trades as an operability criterion, it was discussed that,

1. For New ITIs, the need to opt for minimum 4 trades were based on the following:
  - a. Neglect of Service sector trades attributable to Manufacturing Sector Trades
  - b. To popularise both Engineering and Non-Engineering Trades
  - c. To Increase and Improve Female Enrolment Ratio and encourage Female Participation for Vocational Training

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- d. Also, to reduce Financial Burden of running 4 trades with large capital investments, ITIs are given an option/ opportunity to run a trade with Minimum Expenditure.
2. The rationale behind the point 1 was to restrict poor quality and Garage ITIs from mushrooming across the country.
3. The committee discussed that, the concept of 4 trades maybe applicable to Existing ITIs if we have following mandatory conditions:
  - a. Bar on Minimum no. of units/ Seats an ITI should run
4. It was discussed that at present following constraints are there for existing ITIs
  - a. Land Expansion as per current norms- ITIs may not have land for Expansion of Infrastructure
  - b. Vertical expansion in building due to foundation and structure- Even for vertical expansion, foundation support may not be possible

It was further discussed that, since, at present there is no provision of Government aid to ITIs for expansion and adoption of minimum 4 trades, same should not be insisted to existing ITIs. Also, as reported in response to Questionnaire, running with minimum 4 trades may not be viable for all the ITIs as demand may vary District and State-wise.

Thus, it was recommended that:

1. The 4-trade criterion, at present, may not be implemented on Existing ITIs having less than 4 trades and have Infrastructural constraints for upgradation to 4 trades. Moreover, such ITIs shall further be not allowed for addition of units in existing trades.
2. The ITIs having less than 4 trades, may be allowed for upgradation to 4 trades if they are willing to upgrade to 4 trades by vertical expansion of the building may be allowed, particularly for classrooms and workshops with very light and vibration-free machineries only.
3. The ITIs which are shifting to new location, as per the latest DGT norms, shall adhere to minimum 4 trade criterion
4. As stated in Affiliation norms, all New ITIs will be granted Accreditation in Minimum 4 trades only. No Partial Affiliation will be granted to New ITIs.
5. These recommendations will also be valid for all the applications of existing ITIs pending for approval of DGT.

Respected Madam,

1. DGT as per letter referred here at no. 01 has constituted "Sub Group" under "Grading review committee" and as per letter referred here at no. 02 has nominated the members of the Sub Group and instructed to review gradation process and submit report within 15 days.
2. The prime objective of the Sub group was to review the gradation parameters and gradation process and propose the gradation criteria for existing ITI to apply for addition of Trades and Units as decided by the DGT as per letter referred here at no. 03.
3. The Sub Group has reviewed the entire gradation parameters and discussed with various ITI Principals regarding gradation process. Sub Group has also referred to Grade wise number of ITI.
4. Following is the observation and recommendation of the Sub Group:
  - 4.1. Almost all ITI have faced the Gradation activity for the first time. Some of the ITI are still in the process of Gradation, Grievances and Appellant.
  - 4.2. At present, once ITI Graded, the ITI can apply for gradation only after 5 years. However, many of the gradation parameters depend on annual performance and some on instances, hence the ITI should be given facility to apply for gradation every year. However, the grade granted should be valid for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of grading.
  - 4.3. The larger ITI have advantage of high volume of operations and incomes and perform well on various gradation parameters. Hence, ITI should be promoted to grow up. The present capping of minimum grade for addition of Trade/ Unit shall restrict almost 60% of ITI from expansion. However, ITI on the other side should be encouraged for upgradation and expansion.

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- 4.4. Hence all the ITI having grade 1.25 both Government and Private should be made eligible to apply for addition of Trades and Units. This capping can be further review after 2-3 years and may be enhanced.
5. Point wise and parameter wise comments of Sub Committee on present "Grading of ITI - Framework and Methodology" is attached herewith for kind consideration.

We thank you for providing us the opportunity to review the present framework and methodology of ITI Gradation and submit our comments. We assure to extend all possible support and coordination to enhance the quality of training and thus to find better opportunity for our trainees.

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**Step 2- Field visit and data validation by external agency:**

Self-grading data submitted by ITI will be validated by third party external agency empanelled by DGT. A mobile app may be used for carrying out inspection based on the grading framework. Additional inspections may be carried out by DGT officials as well by State government officials. All such inspection reports will be loaded on online portal. DGT may also assign an official to visit ITIs on sample basis, validate the submitted data and provide scores against grading parameters.

1. At most of the location, the consultant appointed for the physical verification were fresher graduate, who had never even visit any ITI in their tenure. The consultant was totally unaware of the Craftsman Training Scheme (CTS), training activities and training infrastructure in the institutes. They majorly focused on ITI Name Board, Skill India Logo, Compound Wall, Building Coloring, Cosmetic Look, etc. and ignored the basic criteria that directly correlates with institute performance as training infrastructure, admission percentage, passing percentage, dropout, placement percentage, instructor qualification and experience, etc.
2. There is wide network of NSTIs and RDATs across the Country along with State Directorates which can be assigned the responsibility of Gradation. The Services of retired Officers from the DGT and State Directorate can be availed for the said task. Even Inter State Committees can be formed for more transparency.
3. The consultant appointed for the gradation completes physical verification on a single day e.g. physical verification Govt. ITI, Mumbai – 11, Govt. ITI, Mulund, Govt. Nashik all having 80+ units, was done on a single day, which otherwise would have required at least 2-3 days for physical verification of such big institutes.
4. The Institute were not even informed about the information that was uploaded by the consultant through the Mobile App. The consultant didn't even seek any clarification from the respective institute before uploading the reports and was always in hurry to complete the process in a single day.
5. The consultant used mobile app for uploading documents during physical verification. The mobile app permitted only 3-4 documents to be uploaded and hence incomplete reports/ documents are uploaded. The consultant carried physical copies and assured the Institutes that they shall upload them from their offices. However, no documents were uploaded later on.
6. If the services of external third party is taken then the consultant visiting the ITI should be from the skill domain with appropriate experience of the CTS and ATS scheme and thus understands the functioning of ITI, correlates the documents provided to substantiate the parameters.

7. The unprofessional way of Physical Verification by inexperienced consultant can be seen through the deviation among various stages of Gradation.

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
