Subject: Grading criteria for the ITIs affiliated after July 2019

Madam/Sir,

Directorate General of Training (DGT) under aegis of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) had undertaken grading of ITIs in the country. DGT had made it compulsory for all existing ITIs to participate in the grading exercise.

Further, to improve the quality of training and learning outcomes of trainees coming from ITIs, DGT had linked grading criteria with addition of trades/units in existing ITIs.

All the ITIs affiliated till 31st July 2019 were considered for grading by DGT. However, many new ITIs affiliated after the cutoff date of 31st July 2019 are not yet graded by DGT.

It has been decided by the Competent Authority that for such ITIs which were not under consideration of grading (i.e. affiliated after 31st July 2019) and desires to add trade/unit, for such applications grading criteria will not be imposed for addition of trades/units.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
