**Subject: Extension of last date of Examination Fee Submission for March 2024 CTS Semester System Supplementary Examination-reg**

Sir/Madam,

You may be aware that the Supplementary Examination for Semester System trainees under Craftsmen Training Scheme of Academic Session 2017-19 is scheduled in March 2024.

The NCVT MIS Portal for submitting Examination Fees had been opened on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2024.

However, till date, out of 2,85,634 eligible trainees of the 2017-19 batch, only 8,932 have submitted Theory Examination fees for Supplementary CBT Examination. The State wise status, as on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2024, for the same is attached at **Annexure I**.

It may be noted that as per the provisions contained in the order no DGE&T 19/04/2011-CD9 (pt.) dated 16<sup>th</sup> July 2014, this would be last chance for the most of the semester system trainees of batch 2017-19 to appear in the Examination.

Hence, it is decided to extend the **last date of Examination fees submission upto 29.02.2024**, to let more trainees to enroll for the examination/ submit the Examination fees. Accordingly, the subsequent processes of the Examinations will be advanced.

Further, State Directorates are requested to make an outreach to trainees and encourage them to submit their Examination fees within extended timeline, if they wish to appear in this Supplementary Semester System Examination for the CTS.
