## **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Subject: Regarding compliance of judgement dated 09.02.2024 passed in WPC 14341/2023 titled as PR Memorial Private ITI Versus DGT.

Whereas, the above subject writ petition was filed by the petitioner i.e PR Memorial Private ITI, Lucknow (MIS Code - PR09900579) inter alia praying to decide the application of the Petitioner for grant affiliation for remaining 4 units in Electrician Trade in compliance with the order dated 10.08.2023 passed by the Hon'ble Court in W.P. (C) No.8729 of 2023 expeditiously and in a timebound manner.

- 2. Whereas the petitioner was granted affiliation in electrician -8(4+4+0) units on 12.10.2023 in compliance of order dated 10.08.2023 passed in WPC 8729/2023. During pendency of the above subject writ, the petitioner was afforded an opportunity vide email dated 16.11.2023 to submit the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the industry partner for the purpose of affiliation of remaining 04 units under the Dual System of Training (DST). Despite the opportunities granted, no effort was made by the petitioner Institute to submit any signed Memorandum of Understanding as proof to RDSDE
- 3. Whereas, the Hon'ble court has disposed of the matter vide order dated 09.02.2024 inter alia directing to take a decision qua the petitioner's request for permitting another 4 units in the Electrician trade. In the event, the respondent is inclined not to grant the petitioner's prayer for further 4 units in the Electrician trade, the respondent is directed to issue a notice to the petitioner setting out the reason for its proposed decision, so that the petitioner can respond to the notice and also to grant an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner before taking the decision.
- 4. It is pertinent to mention that the execution of MOU with an industrial Partner is essential, so that specialized training for the employable skills could be imparted to the trainees. The MOU is a pre-requisite under the DST scheme and same can't be bypassed. The petitioner has to abide by the policies and notifications issued by the Centre and the State Government. The detailed guidelines of DST are readily available in public domain and may be accessed at DST Download Guidelines-DUAL SYSTEM OF TRAINING | Directorate General of Training (dqt.qov.in)
- 5. Therefore, in compliance to above subject judgement, the petitioner institute was granted a last and final opportunity to submit the signed copy of

MoU of the relevant industry to state directorate of UP and RDSDE UP both, within 15 days from issue of the email 27.02.2024. It was categorically mentioned that in case, the petitioner fails to submit the MOU in aforesaid timelines, no further opportunities shall be granted and the affiliation under remaining 04 units under 3rd shift shall be rejected.

6. That the petitioner didn't avail the opportunity and failed to submit the relevant MoU to RDSDE within given time frame. Therefore, the application for remaining 4 units in 3<sup>rd</sup> shift of Electrician Trade is hereby "Rejected".
