Affiliation of ITIs for the year 2025

Sir/ Madam,

This is in reference to letter dated 06.02.2025 (copy enclosed), through which, all the State/UT Directorates were requested to indicate their willingness within 15 days of its issue, to open the NIMI Affiliation Portal for applications related to the affiliation of new ITIs, the addition of trades/units in existing ITIs, and the relocation of ITIs.

2. In response of above-mentioned letter, requests have been received from 20 States/UTs. List of States/UTs from which requests have been received is attached at **Annexure -1**.

3. In this connection, the competent authority has decided to open NIMI affiliation portal for inviting applications for trade/unit addition in Existing ITIs, affiliation of New ITIs and Shifting of ITIs from 17.03.2025 to 30.04.2025 for States/ UTs as given in Annexure -1. These States/UTs may issue notification and advertisements for inviting applications on NIMI affiliation portal.

4. Applications received shall be processed in accordance with the procedures outlined in the 2018 affiliation manual, as well as any subsequent guidelines and norms issued by DGT. Applying on the NIMI affiliation portal does not guarantee affiliation. These applications will be processed in the order they are received, following the completion of pending applications from previous sessions, on a first-come, first-served basis.

5. Applicants may also be informed that they must upload valid 'No Objection Certificate' (NOC) from concerned State/UT Directorate while applying on NIMI affiliation portal.



Subject: Opening of NIMI Affiliation Portal for Inviting Applications for Accreditation/Affiliation of ITIs for 2025

This is regarding the opening of the NIMI affiliation portal to invite applications for new accreditation and affiliation of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) for the year 2025.

2. As you are aware, Directorate General of Training (DGT) invites application proposals for the affiliation/accreditation of new ITIs, addition of trades/units in existing ITIs, shifting the location of existing ITIs, and changing the name of existing ITIs on the NIMI affiliation portal.

3. These applications are processed in three stages, followed by Desktop Assessment (DA) conducted by the respective State/ UT Directorates. In previous years (2020, 2022, 2023, and 2024), the NIMI portal was opened for applications. However, it has been observed that 794 affiliation applications from these years remain pending at the DA level with the State Directorates.

4. It is important to note that applications received on the NIMI portal are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. This implies that unless the pending DAs from previous years are cleared, new applications cannot be processed. This backlog causes delays in processing and creates a cycle of delayed affiliations.

5. For the year 2025, DGT plans to open the NIMI affiliation portal in March/April 2025. However, considering the existing backlog of pending applications, all State/ UT Directorates are requested to confirm their willingness to invite new applications by responding to this letter within 15 days of its issue. If no response is received within the stipulated timeframe, it will be inferred that the State/UT does not wish to invite applications for 2025. Consequently, the portal will remain closed for applications from those States/UTs.
