**Sub: De-Affiliation of trade/units of Jay Bajarangbali Private Industrial Training Institute (PR09900225) of  
Uttar Pradesh State- regarding.**

Madam/Sir,

This is in reference to the Compliance of the Hon'ble court's order dated 04.10.2023 passed in W.P.(C) 12190/2019 Jay Bajarangbali Private ITI Versus Directorate General of Training inter alia directing the respondents to carry out the inspection of petitioner ITI at new site.

In compliance with the Hon'ble Court's directions, the petitioner ITI was informed via email dated 04.10.2023 to keep the infrastructure ready for a joint inspection. The inspection was subsequently conducted on 25.05.2024, following prior intimation from RDSDE Uttar Pradesh dated 29.12.2023. The deficiencies observed during the joint inspection, along with opportunities for their rectification, were duly communicated to the ITI through the 17<sup>th</sup> SCAA meeting dated 15.07.2024 to 16.07.2024 , 18<sup>th</sup> SCAA meeting dated 21.11.2024 and 20<sup>th</sup> SCAA meeting dated 24.02.2025 . Despite these multiple opportunities, the ITI failed to address the identified deficiencies.

Thereafter, the matter was revisited in the 22nd Standing Committee on Accreditation and Affiliation (SCAA) held on 16.06.2025. Based on the outcomes of the previous SCAA meetings—wherein the petitioner ITI was given multiple opportunities to rectify the identified deficiencies but failed to comply, therefore, the 22<sup>nd</sup> SCAA decided to reject the ITI's shifting application and recommended de-affiliation of the petitioner ITI from its existing location on the NCVT portal with effect from the 2025–26 session.

Hence, the ITI is de-affiliated from its existing location along with its existing trades/units, as mentioned in Annexure-I, with effect from the 2025–26 session.

The Institutes and the State Directorate shall ensure that all the trainees who were already enrolled in the previous sessions, complete the training duration and no fresh trainees are admitted.

Further, the ITI is debarred from submitting any application for a period of three years from the date of issuance of this office order.

The prayers made by the petitioner (PR09900225 - Jay Bajarangbali Private Industrial Training Institute) in the above petition relate to directions to the respondent-Directorate General of Training (DGT) to conduct a joint inspection of the premises of the petitioners at their new locations. The grievance raised by the petitioners is that the respondent-DGT is inspecting the old locations of the petitioners ignoring the fact that the petitioners have already set up new infrastructure at their new proposed locations. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, therefore, submits that if the joint inspection is conducted at new locations, the respondent-DGT would be in a better position to appreciate as to whether the petitioners fulfil the necessary requirements or otherwise.</p> <p>2. The present petition was disposed of along with connected matters (SS Pvt ITI and Jai Bajrang Bali ITI) on 04.10.2023 inter alia directing the respondents to carry out the inspection at new site and take a decision within 04 weeks from the inspection, and to be bound by submission given by our learned counsel. Further the Hon'ble court has also passed the direction that till the application of the petitioners-institutions are decided after the joint inspection at their new locations, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioners-institutions by the respondent-DGT.</p> <p>3. In compliance to the above judgment, vide email dated 04.10.2023, the petitioner was given an intimation to keep the infrastructure ready for inspection. RDSDE and state directorate was also informed to create the</p>	<p>SCAA recommended de-affiliation of the ITI from its existing location.</p> <p><b>Reasons of de-affiliation:</b></p> <p>1. The ITI is not adhering to the affiliation norms, as the following major deficiencies were observed during inspection:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Building Completion Certificate was not available during inspection.</li> <li>The Drawing Hall did not comply with the required norms and was found lacking in several aspects.</li> <li>The power load was insufficient (required – 12.2 KW, available – 9 KW);</li> <li>The IT lab was not as per norms.</li> <li>Shortage of instructor was observed during the inspection.</li> <li>Fire Safety Certificate was not available during inspection.</li> <li>The Dead Stock Register and Raw Material Register were not maintained.</li> </ol> <p>2. The petitioner was afforded multiple opportunities through three SCAA meetings—namely the 17th, 18th, and 20th SCAA—to rectify the identified above deficiencies. Despite these repeated opportunities and clear communication via portal and emails, the petitioner failed to take any corrective action to address the deficiencies, which are of a serious and substantive nature resulting in a clear violation of the Affiliation Norms, 2018. This continued non-compliance of affiliation norms 2018 reflects a negligent approach towards the overall functioning of the institute and has a direct adverse impact on the future prospects of the trainees, undermining both the quality of training and the well-being of the trainees.</p> <p>Hence, the ITI is de-affiliated on NCVT MIS Portal from its existing location along with following existing trades /units:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Electrician -6 (2+2+2)</li> <li>Fitter- 6(2+2+2)</li> </ol>

			<p>batch for inspection and submit the report. The petitioner has applied for shifting in session 2020 at location Village - Gonthu, Post -Khetapur, District: Jaunpur, UP. The case was thereafter put up in 12th SCAA meeting held on 15.12.2023 wherein it was decided that-” RDSDE will create the batch for joint inspection in coordination with the petitioner and state directorate within 01 month from issue of this MoM and submit the report thereafter. The inspection report shall be placed in ensuing next SCAA.”</p> <p>4. A prior intimation was given to the petitioner by RDSDE UP on 29.12.2023 to carry out the inspection at shifted location. The decision of 12th SCAA was also communicated to the petitioner via email dated 17.01.2024 to coordinate with RDSDE for scheduling inspection. Pursuant to coordination with the petitioner, the inspection was scheduled on 24.05.2024. The inspection report was subsequently placed before the 17th SCAA meeting held on 15.07.2024, wherein it was decided to provide the petitioner an opportunity to rectify the deficiencies highlighted by the inspection team and the TC section. The major deficiencies observed included: inadequacies in the Drawing Hall; non-maintenance of the Dead Stock Register and Raw Material Register; insufficient power load (required – 12.2 KW, available – 9 KW); absence of a Fire Safety Certificate and Building Completion Certificate; shortage of instructors; and deficiencies in the IT Lab etc. The MoM of SCAAs are published in the public domain at NCVT MIS portal website and the petitioner was intimated the same via NIMI portal on its registered email id as per DGT online compliance module. A separate notice was also given by DGT via email dated 31.07.2024 to the petitioner by</p>

Subsequently, the petitioner case was placed in 18th SCAA held on _____ wherein it was decided that-” These cases have been discussed with State and RDSDE. SCAA granted one last opportunity to address the deficiencies, as per the 17th SCAA remarks, and submit the compliance report in NIMI portal within 30 days from the issuance of these minutes. If the applicant institute fails to do so, the affiliation application shall be rejected.” The petitioner was again intimated on its registered email through portal via DGT compliance module. However, no action was taken by the petitioner to rectify the deficiencies.</p> <p>6. At last these cases were put up in 20th SCAA held on _____ wherein the petitioner was further granted 3rd opportunity to rectify the deficiencies. The remarks of 20th SCAA was that” Considering the request of the State Directorate, the SCAA has agreed to grant a final extension of two months to applicant institute for the submission of compliance reports, as per the respective SCAA remarks. However, if compliance is not received from the applicant institute within this extended timeline of two months from date of issue of this MoM, the affiliation application shall be rejected, and for seeking affiliation the institutes will be required to apply on the portal, as and when it is open, as per affiliation norms.” This decision was duly communicated to the petitioner via the portal on its registered email ID. However, despite the final extension, the petitioner failed to rectify the deficiencies as pointed out in the inspection report, and the stipulated timeline accordingly lapsed.</p>
