AFFILIATION OF ITI'S WHICH ARE JOINTLY INSPECTED

Existing ITI which had applied on "Online Affiliation Portal" but were not processed by respective State Directorate due to Administrative reasons were taken up for processing Offline and were taken up for Joint Inspection of ITI's in various states for grant of Affiliation for extension of Trades/Units/shifting. However out of 407 ITI, DGT received following reports:

However, on random scrutiny of these reports the Recommendation Committee DGT observed that these reports shall be scrutinized in detail before taking final decision. Accordingly, the Committee decided to place all these reports in its next meeting after well scrutiny by the DGT officers.

Apart from above, a total 28 no. of ITIs of State of UP has submitted in wringing that they are not ready for inspection. In respect of these 28 ITIs, it was decided that these ITIs will be inspected after 6 months only if State Directorate UP clarifies that they are ready for inspection.

In case of Chhattisgarh, joint inspection will be carried out in the 08 ITIs, for which inspection report has been received from DET.

DE-AFFILIATION OF ITI'S IN TELANGANA (FLASH INSPECTION)

30 Private ITI's were inspected (flash Inspection) by DGT officers acting upon complaint received, and ITI's were given chance to represent through Show-cause letter, after verification and analysing the same were proposed for De-affiliation.

After detailed discussion, committee decided as follows:-

- That, these ITIs will be inspected afresh as early as possible by the "High Power Committee" comprising of one/ two officers from DGT, one/two officers from respective State Directorate and one representative from the respective District Collectorate. On receipt of their report, the matter of de-affiliation of the institutes will be decided on its merit by the Recommendation Committee DGT in its very next meeting.
- 2. That, the standard operating procedure for de-affiliation of ITI shall be amended to the extent that upon receipt of serious complaint(s) from the individual directly or through respective State Directorate against the ITIs or otherwise where DGT felt necessary to conduct an inspection of the ITI, a flash inspection may be carried out by the aforesaid High Power Committee. In case serious irregularities are found, a show cause notice to the management of ITI to submit their clarification within 21 calendar days of communication of objections shall be issued. Thereafter, the matter of de-affiliation of the institute shall be decided on its merit by the Recommendation Committee DGT in its very next meeting.
- That, it shall be mandatory for management of ITI to pay the monthly salary/wages to their staff through bank only.

DE-AFFILIATION OF GOVERNMENT ITI, NAVAPUR, MAHARSATRA

Govt. ITI, Navapura, Dist. Nandurbar, Maharashtra was inspected on 20.02.2019 and 21.02.2019 by the officers of RDSDE, Maharashtra. During inspection, team found shortage in infrastructure and faculty and proposed for De-affiliation of 09 trades i.e. 1. Sewing Technology, 2. Dress Making, 3. Welder, 4. Electrician, 5. Fitter, 6. Mechanic Motor Vehicle, 7. Wireman, 8. Sheet Metal Worker and 9. Draftsman (Mech.).

Whereas, on the recommendations of 2^{nd} Recommendation committee DGT Meeting held on 28.03.2019, show-cause notice was issued and State Government vide their letter dt. 18.04.2019 sought time to rectify the deficiencies.

Upon consideration of the facts, the committee was in view of that the aforesaid ITI shall also be inspected by the "High Power Committee" comprising of two officers from DGT, one officer from respective State Directorate and one representative from the respective District Collectorate. On receipt of their report, the matter of de-affiliation of the institutes will be decided on its merit by the Recommendation Committee DGT in its very next meeting.
